Greetings. I hope this email finds you in good health and spirit.

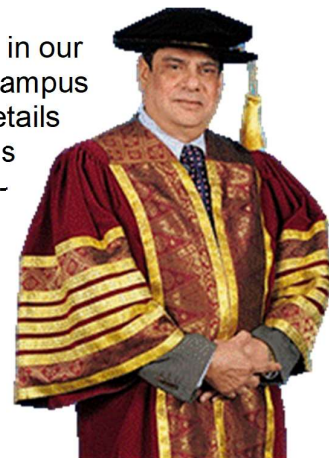
“Another year over and a new one is about to begin.”

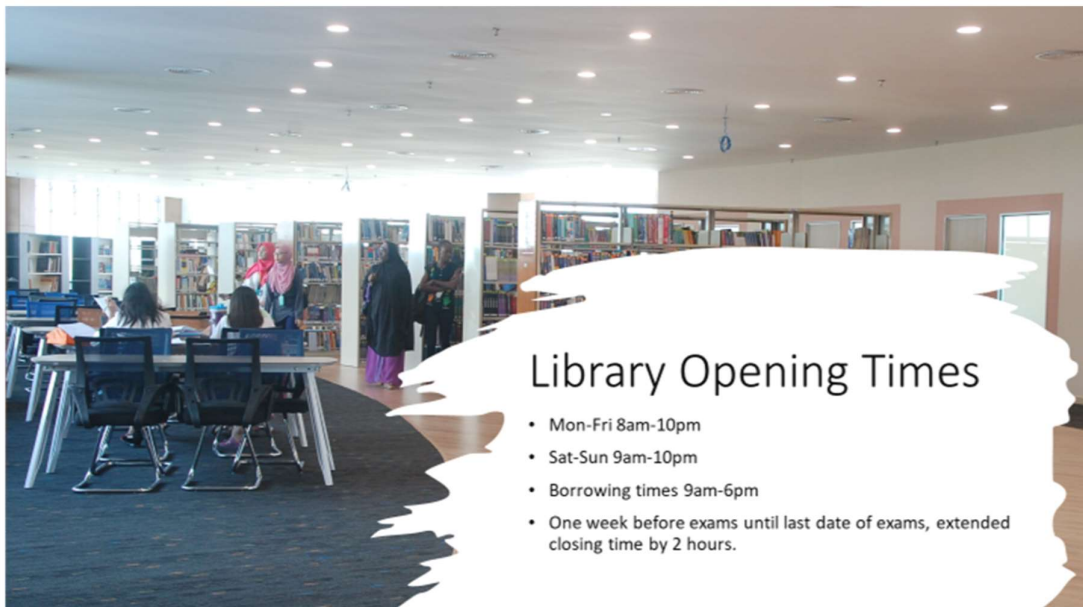


