

- Loss of registration status as active student
- Barred from any form of assessment.

**Note**: Kindly bring along receipt of payment if you have made the payment via online or through CDM machine for further verification by the Finance Department.

As we prepare to welcome you to the campus, we would like to provide guidance on the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) that will be in force.

### **ENTRY INTO THE CAMPUS**

In order to regulate entry into the college, two (2) entrances have been set up:

Accessibility	Entrance
Category 1: Student who are staying in the hostel	Block C, MAHSA Avenue
Category 2: Daily travel students and staff of MAIC	Block A, Main Entrance, Level G

### **IMPORTANT:**

Only **FULLY VACCINATED** individuals are allowed entry into the campus. This will be strictly enforced by college personnel at both entry points.

Steps for entry into the Campus (Only for Fully Vaccinated Persons):

1) Scan the MySejahtera QR Code available at the entrance.

Display your MySejahtera Check-in information for our Entry Personnel to verify your Vaccination Status.

2) Scan the MAIC Student QR Code (available only at Block A entrance) and key in your temperature for

college records.

NOTE: Anyone detected to have a temperature of 37.5 Degrees and above, or who display Covid-19 symptoms

vill not be allowed entry, and are advised to immediately seek medical attention.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES WHILE ON CAMPUS:** 

MAIC has implemented the following safety measures during this pandemic period, which are:

1. It is Compulsory for all Staff, Students and Guests to wear a mask upon entering the campus area.

2. Social distancing to be practiced all times.

3. It is compulsory to record your entrance in areas such as café, library, etc. using MySejahtera QR Code.

4. Use the hand sanitizer provided at all main entrances to building and lifts.

5. Disinfecting common areas and classrooms.

In the event, if a student fails to comply with any of the Safety & Health measures, a compoundable fine of RM1,000.00 will be imposed upon the offender which is in line with the penalty set by the government. Those who are recalcitrant or classified as repeated offenders shall be called to Disciplinary Board for severe disciplinary

action.

College Security Personnel are empowered to deny entry to any persons who may pose a danger to the students

and staff of MAIC. This may also include requesting individuals involved to leave the college immediately.
